## HERE WE INTRODUCE RICCARDO

With Paolo, on the other hand, he was able to experience **laboratory** work firsthand: mixing processes, testing, material trials and that fascinating moment when an idea gradually takes shape and becomes matter.

“Everything was new,” he says.

A simple sentence, able to capture the truest meaning of the internship: a first encounter with a world made not only of theory, but also of everyday practice, details, discussions with experienced professionals and real challenges to face. Among the words Riccardo uses to describe these months, there are two that make us particularly proud: support and availability. Because for us, training first and foremost means guiding and supporting people, creating an environment where newcomers can feel free to observe, ask questions and grow.
